SOPHOMORE COURSES

- Sign In to PowerSchool. USE SAFARI, NOT THE POWERSCHOOL APP. https://ca-net.powerschool.com Use your CA login and password.
- 2. Class Registration Icon—open until May 31—can make changes until then
- 3. Click on tiny box with pencil inside (right side of screen) for course lists.
- 4. The ! mark means you must choose from that subject area. Ignore other marks: green/red.

REOUIRED COURSES:

• Religion II, • English II, Service II, chapel—computer will assign these automatically

Everyone needs 20 hours of community service per year at C.A. to graduate. Service II is the sophomore course to record this community service.

You have room during the day for **3** classes plus chapel. Everything else must be after school.

3 Math—You must take a math every year!

If you are currently in class X take >class Y next year:

- O Algebra I > take Geometry if grade is C or better.
- Algebra I > grade of D -- take Technical Geometry (Geometry. Tech. is the one with the period after the name)
- o If you failed either semester of Algebra I, you must re-take entire course this summer ③
- o Geometry>Algebra II or Technical Algebra II. (with period at end of name, not for CA Scholars or Pre-Cal)
- o Algebra II>Pre-Cal or AP Statistics —see below
- o Pre-Cal>AP Calculus or AP Statistics

Pre-Calculus Requirements:

- 1. A or B grade in Algebra II.
- 2. Completion of non-technical track Alg. 1, Geometry, and Alg. 2.
- 3. Teacher recommendations/approval from math department.
- 4. ACT Math score of 19 or greater and highly motivated students.

AP Statistics Requirements:

Prerequisite: ACT Math score of 19 or greater and highly motivated students who have completed <u>regular</u> Algebra II with a strong performance.

4 Science:

Advanced Geoscience > Biology

To Graduate: you must have Biology, Chemistry **OR** Physics, and 1 other science (Advanced Geoscience).

You should take Chemistry or Physics ONLY after completing Biology.

CA Scholars requires 4 sciences: Advanced Geoscience, Biology, Chemistry and either Physics or A & P.

6 History:

World History, you cannot take U.S. History before taking World History. If you took World History as a freshman, select it anyway. Put your name on this paper with a note about World History and give to Miss Conerly. It will be fixed on the administrative side of the program.

6 Foreign Language: 2 years of same language

- Spanish I or II
- o French I 2017-2018; French II 2018-2019

CHOICES for classes 7& 8:

Fine Art: need 2 full credits to graduate. Each course is 1 credit per year.

Art Appreciation, Band, Bella Voce, FrontMen, Chamber Orchestra, Color and Design, Sculpture

Jazz Band may only be taken in conjunction with concert band.

Upperclassmen have first chance for Sculpture seats as space is limited.

PE:

5 of 8 semesters of PE required for graduation includes year of Wellness that has 1 semester of PE and 1 semester of health. If you didn't take Wellness, then it's still 2.5 years of PE.

Technology/Practical Arts:

Need 1.0 credit to graduate.

Example: Study Skills = .5 then one semester of any of these:

Home Maintenance, Life Skills, Advanced Woodworking, new computer courses, new ACT Prep/Career course
