

## Educate = Equip = Inspire = Serve

Dear Collegedale Academy Elementary families,

This holiday season the Collegedale Academy Elementary family is excited to once again team up with Samaritan's Purse and Operation Christmas Child to provide Christmas gifts for kids around the world. This is an outreach ministry of preparing and packing shoeboxes with toys and gifts for many children who have never received Christmas gifts. Not only does it provide gifts for children, it provides discipleship Bible studies to those receiving Christmas shoeboxes as well.

This year we are hoping that your child would like to make a Christmas shoe box for a child. This could be a great project for everyone in your family. Bring as many boxes as you would like. Take 30 minutes and go to the Dollar Store, Wal-Mart, Target, Hobby Lobby, or any other store and choose items to fill a shoe box.

There are some guidelines of what types of things can be in the box. So please look at their website. <u>http://www.samaritanspurse.org/what-we-do/operation-christmas-child/</u>.

Find a shoebox and fill it with toys, games, and fun school supplies. You can find more suggestions online or in the brochures your teachers will or have already sent home. Please keep in mind the gender and age of the child you are buying toys for. Each box will be given to a single child. After you have filled a box, cut off a label from the brochure or print one off online. You can click on the link above to print off a label or process it online. If you process it online you can track which country it goes to from your phone. However, if you have trouble finding it online, or cannot find the brochure that was sent home, I have many more available at school and you could see me or Mrs. Lighthall at the front office for help. Either one of us can help you cut one out and tape it on the top of your box if you are not able to get one.

Samaritan's Purse does ask for a \$10 donation for shipping, and the Bible Study book that comes with the boxes. This simply helps defer costs of shipping and Bible study materials. It is the desire of Samaritan's Purse that these kids still receive the box and Bible Studies whether or not you have donated the extra money to defer the cost.

The last day for our collection is 8:15 AM on Tuesday November 19. Or you can bring it any time before this date. Your child can bring the box to their teacher, the front office, or they can bring it directly to my office. On November 19, I will be taking all the boxes to a local drop-off location in Chattanooga.

# Help Savanna GET LIFE SAVING SURGERY

In May 2024, Savanna, a 1st Grader at OAKS, was diagnosed with Non-Cirrhotic Portal Vein Thrombosis—a dangerous blood clot in the portal vein, causing intense pressure in Savanna's organs and leading to poor liver function. This means her body is struggling to filter toxins from her blood. Savanna's body has tried to compensate by creating tiny blood vessels to bypass the blockage, but as she's grown, these fragile vessels can no longer handle the increasing demand, resulting in swelling, immense pressure, and burst veins.

Savanna is in need of life-saving surgery that has been scheduled for November 5 at Nationwide Children's Hospital in Columbus, Ohio.

Her family is humbly requesting prayers and financial support to cover the steep medical expenses expected with this surgery. Any donation, regardless of size, will provide much-needed relief and allow the family to focus entirely on Savanna's healing.


